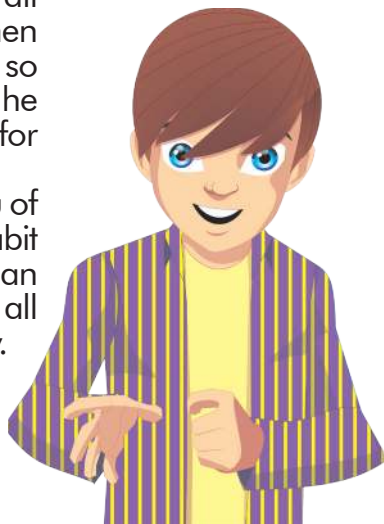
No Excuse

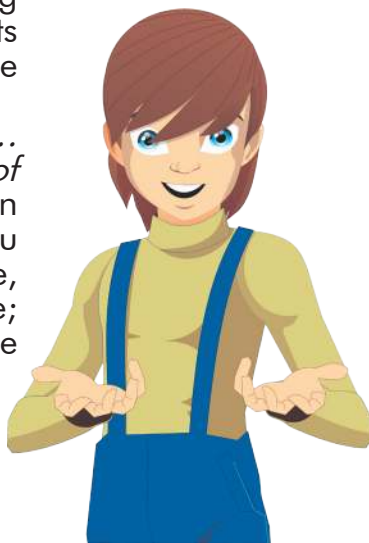
Fruits of Righteousness

2. A certain widow and her son planned to bake bread with the last jar of oil and bin of flour they had left, after which they would go hungry. But the oil and flour multiplied after she met with God's servant - Elijah (1 Kings 17:12-16).
3. Jairus' daughter who was very sick in her body and later died, was brought back to life when the Lord Jesus visited his house (Mark 5:22-24, 35-42).
4. Six pots of washing water became the best wine served at a wedding the Lord Jesus attended together with His mother, and disciples at canna of Galilee (John 2:1-3, 6-10).
5. A certain man, and commander of the army of the king of Syria named Naaman, was healed of a disease called leprosy (2 Kings 5:1, 10-14).

6. The Lord Jesus paid off His tax and Peter's with the piece of money gotten from the mouth of a fish in the river (Matthew 17:27).
7. A man who was blind, had his sight restored when he met with the Lord Jesus (Mark 10:46-52).
