6. In this book, there're thirty-four chapters, and a total of nine hundred and fifty-seven verses.

7. Chapter thirty-four has the shortest number of verses. It has twelve verses!
8. The chapter with the longest number of verses in this book is chapter twenty-eight. It has sixty-eight verses.
9. Two chapters in Deuteronomy have both number of chapter and number of verses alike. They are: Chapter twenty having twenty verses and Chapter twenty-nine having twenty nine verses.
10. Deuteronomy has a few farewell messages by Israel's one hundred and twenty year-old leader, Moses.

The Tree And Its Fruits

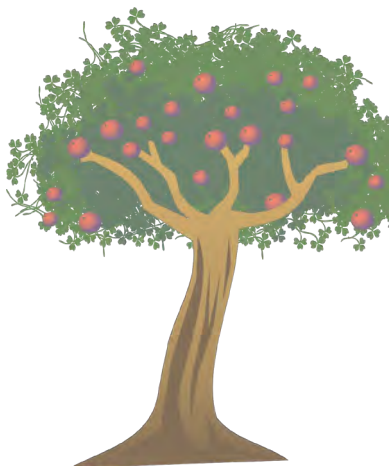

Street Rules

When using the street, it might be for a casual stroll or a walk to catch the school bus, there are rules that will help keep you safe. Here are a few:
